PEKIN TESTING SITE Heartland Health Services has added a Pekin site for COVID-19 test collections. Testing collection by drive-through or walk-up will take place on MONDAY & WEDNESDAY from 9am – 4pm at Tazwood Center for Wellness, 3248 Van De Ver Ave., Pekin, IL. Anyone age 18 and older with or without COVID-19 related symptoms can be tested. Testing is no cost to the public; bring an ID card; bring insurance documents if available but not required.

HOW THE VIRUS SPREADS

- You could spread COVID-19 to others even if you do not feel sick.
- Everyone should wear a cloth face cover when they have to go out in public, for example to the grocery store or to pick up other necessities.
 - Cloth face coverings should not be placed on young children under age 2, anyone who has trouble breathing, or is unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance.
- The cloth face cover is meant to protect other people in case you are infected.
- Do NOT use a facemask meant for a healthcare worker.
- Continue to keep about 6 feet between yourself and others. The cloth face cover is not a substitute for social distancing.

<u>FOLLOW STAY AT HOME ORDERS - It is very important to limit the spread.</u> <u>Assume that you have been exposed.</u> <u>Staying home will reduce the number of people that you expose.</u>

Non-Pharmaceutical Interventions (NPI) are ways to limit exposure to others who may be ill. These include:

- Personal
 - Every day cover, clean, stay home
 - Voluntary home quarantine if exposed to ill person
- Community
 - Wear a face covering indoors.
 - Social Distancing at least 6 feet between you and other individuals.
 - School closure with internet learning
 - Business working remotely, teleconferencing for meetings
 - Mass gathering cancelled/postponed.
 - Healthcare will triage differently, cancel elective surgeries

CLEANING

- Ensure prescribed cleaning is happening at facilities (routine disinfectants are appropriate).
 - o Enhance cleaning of high touch surfaces like doorknobs, toilet handles, and sink handles.
 - Ensure that hand sanitizer, soap/paper towels and tissues are widely available.
 - o Encourage everyone to cover their coughs/sneezes with their elbow.
